# Director of Church Engagement & Mobilization

## JOB PURPOSE

Reporting to the Sr. Director, this role will engage and mobilize church leaders in the emerging US Church Mobilization Program. The Director will steward the organization's missiological and theological values and play a pivotal role in executing the organizations' program, spiritual formation, and other organizational practices. They will share Living Water's mission with church/denomination leaders and congregations and will serve as an organization spokesperson among key Christian networks carrying a portfolio of 100 to 150 faith-based accounts.

## KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collaborate with the CEO, CDO, Sr. Director and fellow Directors to execute the domestic church mobilization practices in order to deliver on Living Water's vision for Integral Mission expansion and ensure a world-class experience for churches;
- Serve as a contributing member of the team of church mobilizers to establish and nurture church partnerships in a way that edifies each church, serves the mission, and glorifies God;
- Identify opportunities to strategically connect highly engaged U.S. churches with local churches (or church networks) in developing countries, to expand Integral Mission to more people and places of great need;
- Support the CDO, CEO and Sr. Director in the implementation of national/local church mobilization strategies in developing contexts;
- Working through the Sr. Director, annually develop and implement Living Water's mobilization offerings for the US Church; focusing on:
  - o Identifying and disrupting the "someday" mindset regarding missions. A "someday" mindset impedes movement and ultimately alignment with God's mission. Someday is today!
  - o Promoting a shift from a one-off-mission-project approach to strategic mission partnerships, encouraging a concentrated, collective effort to pray, give and go for the purpose of positively impacting unreached peoples.

- Amplification of the missions conversation into more than a special announcement or sermon. Missions are not a simple announcement or message dusted off and preached behind the podium once a year. Engaging with Living Water International and mobilizing the global church should be positioned as the engine that drives forward the process of cultivation for sustainable water, better sanitation and hygiene programs, and on ongoing witness to the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Changing the mindset that the gathering on Sunday morning is not a final destination, rather it can serve as a launching pad for action.
- Represent Living Water's mission through preaching/public speaking engagements;
- Establish relationships with denomination leaders and catalyze joint, Kingdom-focused initiatives;
- Maintain a portfolio of church accounts with revenue goals as drafted and agreed upon annually;
- Plan and coordinate a series of regional meetings and/or conferences to engage church leaders and faith-based groups in the effort to link arms in support of the Great Commission;
- Serve in a contributing member role with key industry coalitions convening forums, and collaborating with various third-party organizations or networks to establish value-for-value partnerships.
