- Train and oversee hygiene and sanitation facilitators as well as verify the correct application of all classes shared to the community members.
- Assess H&S data collected, analyze, and develop training materials to address gaps.

- Document a training plan, develop a field report of training interventions, and update the Program Manager in a timely manner.
- Participate in training of community members, schools, churches, and other beneficiaries in the H&S promotion strategy.
- Ensure records, reports and logs of trainings undertaken are up-to-date and submitted to the Program Manager
- Act as liaison between LWI and other WASH organizations or local partners implementing hygiene promotions.
- Monitor and review promotions on a regular basis and be able to take corrective actions, if needed
- Ensure Living Water Global Quality standards and H&S guidelines are being met.
- Ensure and oversee H&S Facilitators keep all supplies and materials ready to use for the classes in the communities by maintaining the proper inventory and budget.
