We believe that the next step is creating new value through our core operational systems, enabling service and data-informed decision-making that furthers our mission of water, for life, in Jesus' name.

In this role, you will be instrumental in converting our strategy into better system design and process efficiency. Your responsibilities will include three areas: a) strategic leadership b) technical design and development, and c) team management and user support

- **Strategic Leadership:**
 - Develop a comprehensive product roadmap for Salesforce in collaboration with the Salesforce Oversight Council (governance team), prioritizing new functionality across Donor Engagement, Programs, and Support Services.
 - Collaborate with business leaders to understand their challenges, explain what's possible through technology, and design options with clear trade-off considerations.

- Serve as the Salesforce platform visionary, explaining emerging trends in technology, defining long-term architecture decisions, and guiding prioritization methods.
- Design Salesforce data architecture that enables rapid, data-informed decision making by leaders, supporting predictive analytics and machine learning.
- **Technical Design & Development:**
 - Design and implement scalable, high-performance Salesforce architectures that meet current and future business needs, supported by clear architectural documents.
 - Configure new Salesforce features, leveraging automation tools (e.g., flows) for streamlined processes.
 - Ensure adherence to industry's best practices and security standards, including managing scheduled Salesforce release updates.
 - Work closely with stakeholders to discover and document business requirements, ensuring seamless integration with the broader system architecture (Classy, Pardot, FormAssembly, Firebase).
 - Develop and manage APIs or data flows for necessary integrations (ex: Make.com, Flutterflow).
 - Source development work to the appropriate internal staff or external contractors throughout the development lifecycle, manage accountability to assure timely deliverables.
- **Team Management & User Support:**
 - Mentor and guide Salesforce team members, fostering a culture of learning and innovation.
 - Manage the Salesforce team for user account management, reporting & dashboards, and other routine tasks.
 - Manage cross-functional project teams.
 - Promote new Salesforce functionality rollouts in collaboration with business units, including internal communication and training.
 - Manage a ticket support system to identify end user issues, document solutions, communicate progress, and track resolution time.
